Now at the QArts Gallery, three exhibits on view through May 4th

"Opalescence", oil paintings by Dorchester artist Vincent Crotty, will immerse you into his world of light and shadow. His canvases are full with brilliant and moody colors and textures. Dan is a long time member of the Quincy Art Association, where he teaches Portrait and Figure Sculpture and coordinates a Life Drawing Class. Dan's exhibit includes thirty-three works of drawings in charcoal, pastel, and pencil, oil paintings and his breathtaking sculptures. Dan's a master sculptor with many prestigious awards. His most recent sculpture, "Faith, Hope, and Love" was a finalist in the Art Renewal Center's 12th International Salon in 2017, which specializes in classical realist art. It is the centerpiece of Dan's exhibit in the QArts Gallery. A must see!
