## Cold Wax, Oils, You & Me!

### Must Haves...

- Baseboard
- Oil Brush
- Paper towels
- Palette knife

Above are just a few items I grabbed quickly. With the Bondo or Squeegee spreaders either/or is fine. Credit cards work too. You will need Gamsol thinner or similar. Oil paints for sure, your choice and masking tape. • Oil crayons, pastels, charcoal are all good, one of them would be fine. Latex gloves are fine if you want the protection. Paint brushes if you want should be oil brushes no smaller than a #8 for now.

For the paper, as long as it is white or off white, at least 140 lb. weight stock. It can be water-color paper cold pressed or a rough surface stock (more interesting). It can be in a blocked pad or loose sheeted pad. Strathmore has some nice pads.

We'll be working on paper that will be tapped down to a Masonite baseboard. We'll be working no larger than 9"x12" for now. If you want to bring another type of baseboard be sure it is firm, No illustration or fomCore please. If you want to use canvas board it still needs to be taped to a firm baseboard.

Interesting papers, newsprint, magazine text or any photos you like, are always good if you want to collage eventually but not needed at first. Any mark making items are fine like combs, forks, sponges, bag netting, etc. Think texture lots of textures!

I will bring lots of materials so don't panic. The first week will be a quick take on all of this and we'll work with whatever we have. There will be time to finesse things down the road.
